



TALENT SEARCH GUIDELINES

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

1 • ATTEND ONE OF THE ORIENTATION SESSIONS

Any artist who wishes to participate in DC TALENT SEARCH must first attend a DC ORIENTATION session while visiting the convention. The Orientation will provide valuable information and insight on how to be a successful professional artist. You will also learn how and where to submit portfolio samples for review (look for times and locations in your convention handout).

2 • SUBMIT ONLY PHOTOCOPIES OF YOUR WORK

Once your DC Orientation is complete, artists will be permitted to drop off PHOTOCOPIES ONLY of their work (no original artwork or portfolio cases will be accepted at the drop-off location). Artists should include a minimum of 6 pages (12 pages maximum) in their photocopy packages. The copies can be black & white or color, and range in size from 8.5"x11" to 11"x17". Artists must write their NAME, PHONE NUMBER and/or E-MAIL ADDRESS at the top of each page.

The drop-box is located at the DC Comics booth.

3 • ATTACH THE "DC INFORMATION FORM" TO YOUR SAMPLES

The DC TALENT SEARCH INFORMATION FORM must be stapled to your photocopied samples. Artists may download this form online at www.dccomics.com/about/submissions.html or receive one at the DC ORIENTATION. These forms will not be available at the DC Comics booth.

4 • RETURN THE FOLLOWING DAY TO CHECK SCHEDULING

All submissions will be reviewed at the end of each day (except the final day of the convention) by a team of DC Editors and Art Directors. If you are selected from the submissions, your NAME, INTERVIEW TIME, and MEETING PLACE will be posted (the day after you submit) on the DC booth video screens. You must return to the DC booth in the morning in order to see if you have been selected. If you do not see your name, it doesn't mean your work was not reviewed.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Artists may only submit once to DC TALENT SEARCH at any given convention.
- Samples submitted to DC TALENT SEARCH will not be returned.
- DC TALENT SEARCH does not review writing samples (artwork only).
- Do not mail your portfolio samples to DC Comics. DC does not accept unsolicited submissions.
